Various Clubs of the Department

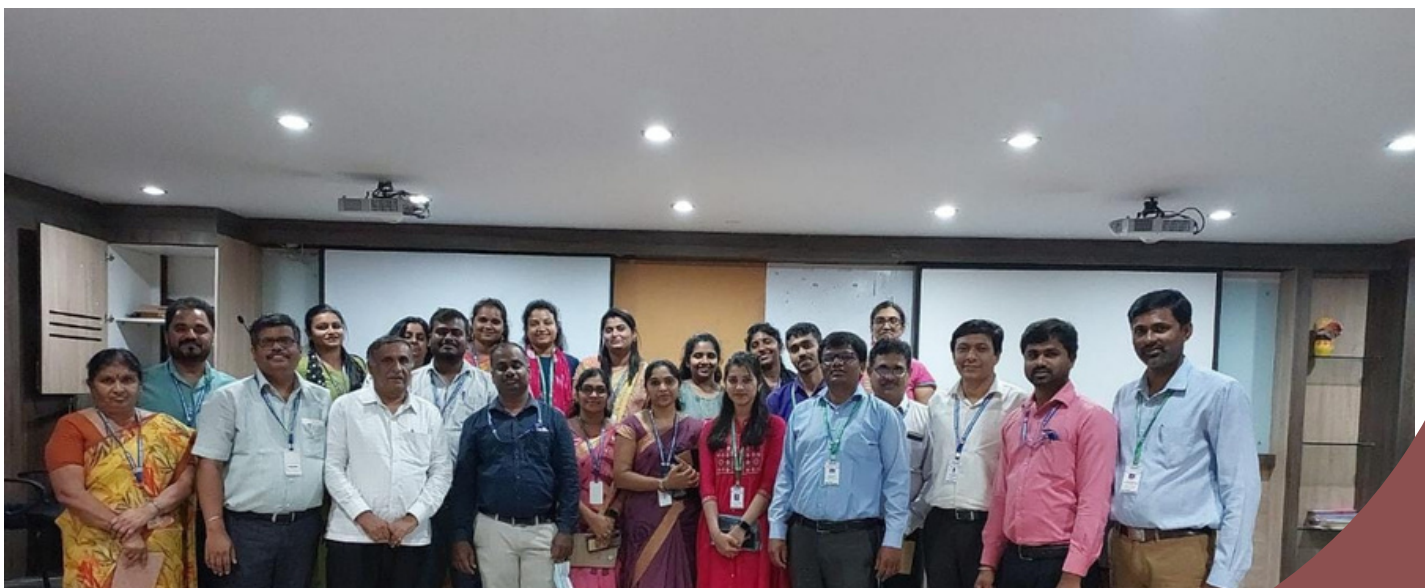

In addition to the traditional chalk-and-talk method classes, special interactive classes by asking questions, group discussions, and conducting demonstrations encourage the students and thereby improve their learning. Since globalization, Kannada language is overlooked by English. Therefore reading and writing Kannada have not been taught properly during all the stages. Even at the degree level, students do not know to write and read Kannada correctly. So, we try to teach writing and reading properly by conducting practical activities.
