



1. Are you satisfied with the infrastructure provided by the college?




2. Does the college have adequacy, Accessibility and Quality of Teaching-LearningResources?




3. The teachers illustrate the concepts through examples and applications.




4. How much of the syllabus was covered in the class?




5. How well did the teachers prepare for the classes?










