
Dhanavantri saplings plantation on campus

Webinar-Unifluenced mind: A Glorious Life
















Covid19 Awareness Programme




Webinar on Reinventing in Lockdown


National webinar on Road to Success with reference to Jack Ma Life Story








Webinar -Capital Market





Virtual Interaction-How Can I be Successful in IAS/KAS Exams







National Webinar on Rajayoga for happiness




Webinar on Power of Youth to Bring about Positive Change in Society




Alumni Meet 2020







Misconceptions of Pandemic




Shwas – Vishwas

Organizational Transformation - A Knowledge Management Approach



on knowledge management and its contribution to the transformation of an organization. More than 1100 members registered for the webinar from various parts of the country and world.


Capacity Building Week







Webinar on Industry 4.0



Guest lecture on Banking and Finance





Webinar on Augmented Reality and its applications










Positive Practice through Meditation and Breath

All the team members demonstrated various meditation and breathing exercises during the webinar. So, all the students practiced those during the webinar and felt relaxed and gained better concerntration levels.




Webinar on Ethical Hacking




Webinar on Play with Mathematics

Experiential Learning: Preparation of Hand Sanitizer

Preparation of Hand Sanitizer and Disinfectant for Prevention of spread of COVID -19 The students of Chemistry prepared alcohol based hand sanitizer under the guidance of Head of the Department, Miss. Sushma A V, Asst. Professor of Chemistry. The hand sanitizer is prepared as per the World Health Organization's (WHO) specifications. For preparation of 1000ml (1Ltr.) of hand sanitizer, reagents are mixed in following proportion: 99.8% Isopropyl Alcohol- 751.5 ml; 3% Hydrogen Peroxide-41.7 ml; 98% Glycerol— 14.5 ml; 192.3 ml of distilled water or cooled boiled water.





Neem based disinfectant to disinfect campus

The procedure adopted for the preparation of Neem based disinfectant is 100 grams of Neem leaves added to 1 litre of water. The mixture was boiled together. Then, about 50 grams of turmeric powder and about 20 grams of camphor added. The contents are mixed thoroughly by stirring. The mixture is allowed to stand for 24 hours. Finally, the mixture is filtered and poured into dispensing container for use.
