Sowmiya Rani from Editage delivered an insightful session on the integration of AI tools into scientific writing and their profound impact on the research ecosystem.

Objectives:


- 1. To introduce researchers, students, and academic professionals to the latest AI tools used in scientific writing.
- 2. To demonstrate how AI tools can enhance the efficiency, accuracy, and overall quality of research manuscripts.
- 3. To help researchers reduce time spent on drafting, editing, and formatting, allowing them to concentrate more on their core research activities.

Key highlights:

Dr. K.S. Sowmiya Rani provided an in-depth overview of various AI tools that assist researchers throughout the scientific writing process. She discussed tools such as Grammarly, which improves grammar, syntax, and style in real-time, and QuillBot, an AI-based paraphrasing tool for enhancing content flow. Reference management tools like Zotero and Mendeley were highlighted for organizing citations, while DeepL was introduced as an accurate translation tool for multilingual publications. Specialized tools like Trinka AI, designed for academic writing, and SciNote, an AI-powered electronic lab notebook for organizing research data, were also covered. Additionally, she explained the Editage AI Suite, a comprehensive solution for language editing, plagiarism detection, and journal-specific formatting. The session emphasized the practical application of these tools to streamline the writing process, improve quality, and meet journal requirements effectively.

Learning outcomes:

- Gained practical knowledge of AI tools that improve the quality, accuracy, and efficiency of scientific writing.
- Developed an understanding of how to integrate AI tools into the writing process to streamline tasks like editing and formatting.
- Increased awareness of the ethical considerations when using AI in scientific research and writing.
