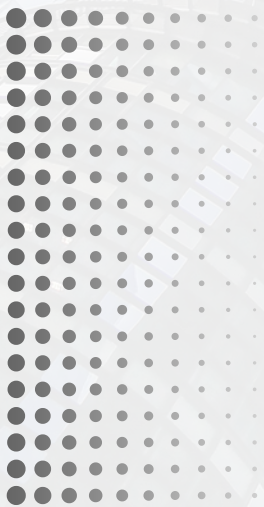


- To encourage students to explore their values and engage in self-reflection, and connect with their inner selves.




Action Taken Report (ATR)

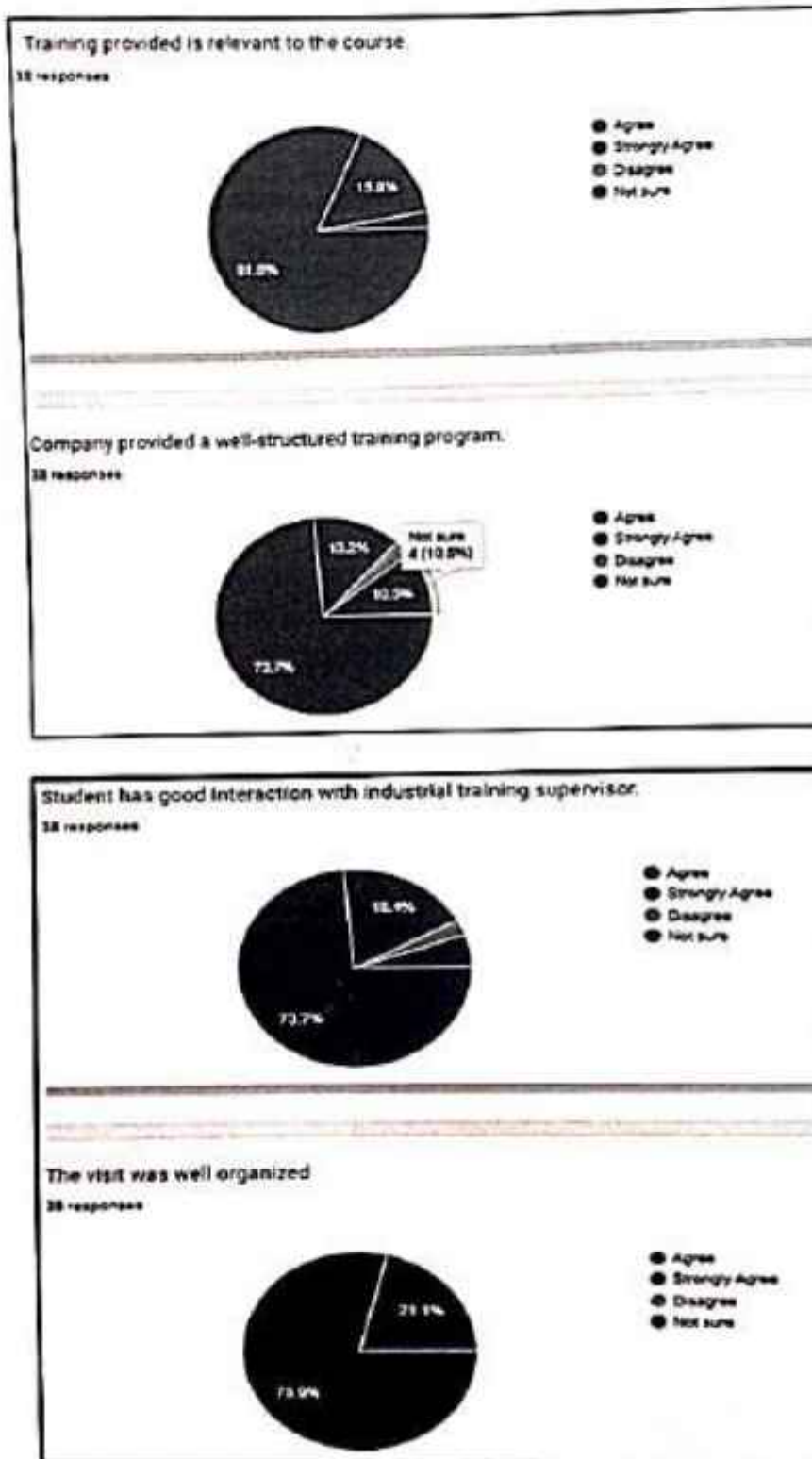
