

Question 1: How would you rate the overall impact of the workshop on your understanding of gender-related issues?




The majority of participants found the workshop's impact on their understanding of gender-related issues to be very positive, with only a small number having neutral or negative views.

She spoke about menstrual hygiene and laid importance on the menstrual cup- the latest innovation which can replace pads as they are more affordable and accessible. She also emphasized on the taboos associated with menstrual products. The talk was followed by the question and answer session wherein the students went forward and asked their questions to which the guest speaker was requested to clear their doubts for which she gave clear-cut yet simple and comprehensive answers.

Further, the guest was felicitated by the Mrs. Thanuja, Convenor, Women's Wing. The session concluded with a vote of thanks delivered by Ms. Madhuri of 6th<sup>st</sup> sem B.Com which brought end to a fruitful event.

#### 2. Workshop Execution:


- a. Conducted a session on the scheduled date, ensuring all logistical arrangements were in place.

#### 3. Post-Workshop Actions:


- a. Circulated online feedback forms to participants to gather their opinions and suggestions for improvement.

The audience comprised enthusiastic students and faculties who actively participated in the discussions and appreciated the cultural performances.






How do you rate the content / activity of the session 8 responses
