Teacher's feedback on curriculum for the year 2022-23

Conclusion:

- 1. 70% of the teachers agree that the designed curriculum aligns well with the program, with clearly defined objectives and outcomes for each course.
- 69% of the teachers agree that the syllabus reflects contemporary and industry-oriented content, presented in a progression from simple to complex.
- 3. 86% of the teachers agree that program objectives are successfully achieved through course outcomes, although there is room for improvement in the curriculum development procedure.
- 4. 92% of the faculty members agree that they enjoy the freedom to adopt new techniques, educational tools, and strategies in teaching, contributing to the attainment of minimum required course outcome levels.

Overall, while there are areas for improvement, the majority of faculty members express satisfaction with the flexibility in teaching approaches and believe that the program effectively achieves its objectives through course outcomes.

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Student's feedback on curriculum for the year 2022-23

Conclusion:

- 89% of students agree that the curriculum provides practical learning experiences essential for diverse skill development, aligning well with realworld scenarios.
- 83% of students affirm that clear and relevant reading material aids learning, while faculty use teaching aids and ICT tools to enhance the learning experience.
- 91% of the students agree that the assessment processes are deemed fair with diverse methods, while ample opportunities for research, internships, and experiential learning are available within the college/university.
- 84% of the students agree that the Out-of-classroom learning opportunities like guest lectures, seminars, workshops, and competitions enhance the overall learning experience.

Overall Students are satisfied with the course curriculum.

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Alumni's feedback on curriculum for the year 2022-23

Conclusion:

- 82% of the alumni agree that the curriculum and syllabus were appropriate for my placement/higher education, with a sufficient number of co-curricular activities arranged during their study period.
- 85% of the alumni agree that the institute's industry tie-ups were proved useful, and faculty assistance with placement/higher education was beneficial.
- 88% of the alumni agree that the institute offers ample scholarships, maintains a good learning ambience, and provides opportunities for both extracurricular and experiential learning.
- 4. 94% of the alumni agree that the academic processes are transparent, and the institute is student-centric in all its academic initiatives.

Overall, the majority of alumni express satisfaction with the institute's curriculum, industry tie-ups, scholarships, learning ambience, and student-centric academic initiatives.

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Employer's feedback on curriculum for the year 2022-23

Conclusion:

- 85% of employers agree that the students exhibit commendable technical knowledge, demonstrating proficiency in their respective fields of study.
- 90% of the employers agree that the curriculum and syllabus are comprehensive, providing ample coverage of relevant subject matter.
- 3. 79% of the employers agree that the communication abilities are noteworthy, and they possess managerial and leadership qualities essential for professional success.
- 83% of employers agree that students readily adapt to industry's dynamic requirements, attributing this ability to the combined efforts of the curriculum and non-curricular initiatives at SIMS, which equip students with essential competencies.

Overall, the employers agree that the students' capabilities reflect a holistic preparation for the demands of the industry, positioning them well for successful careers.
