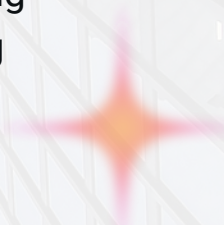

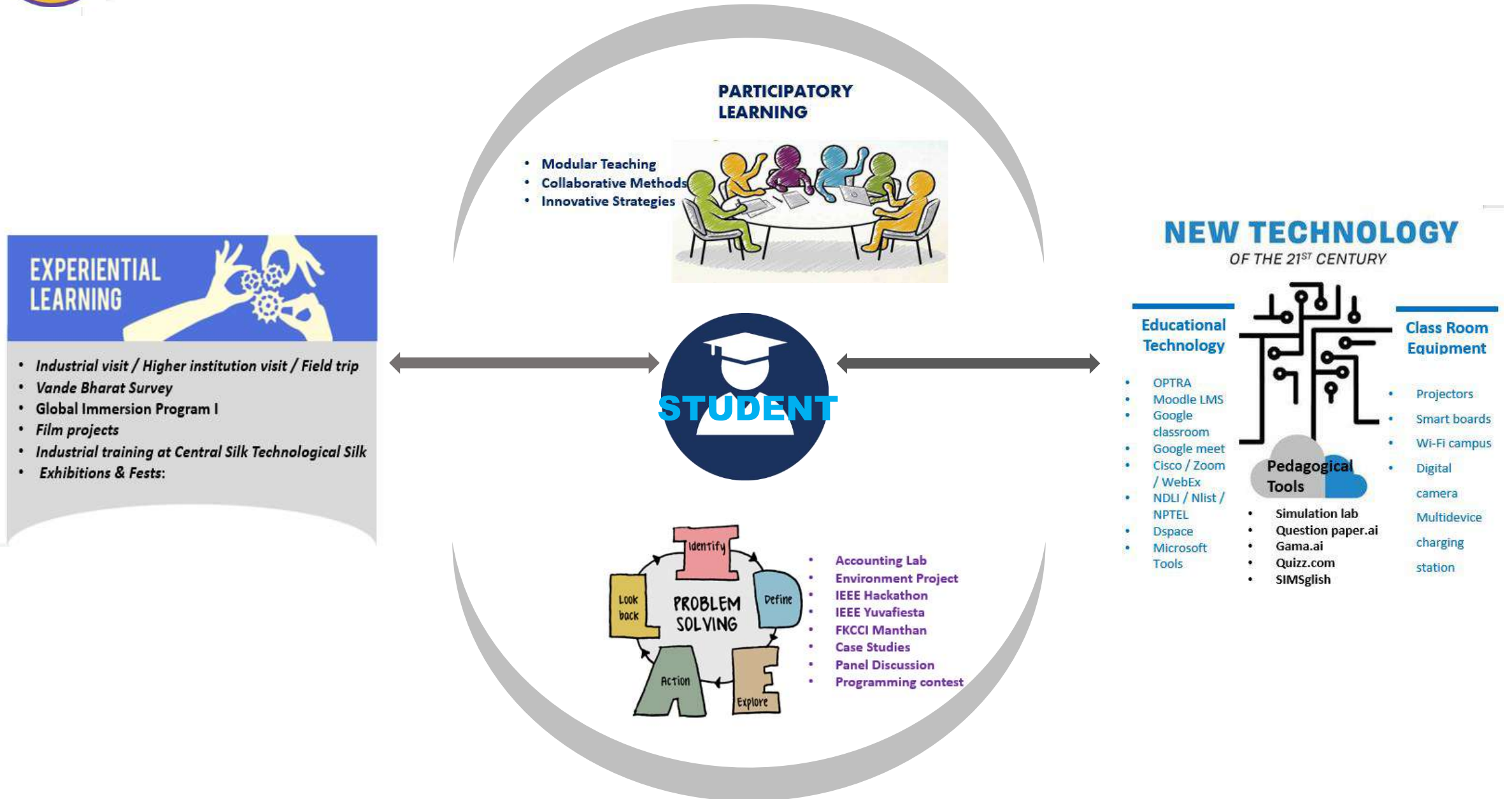

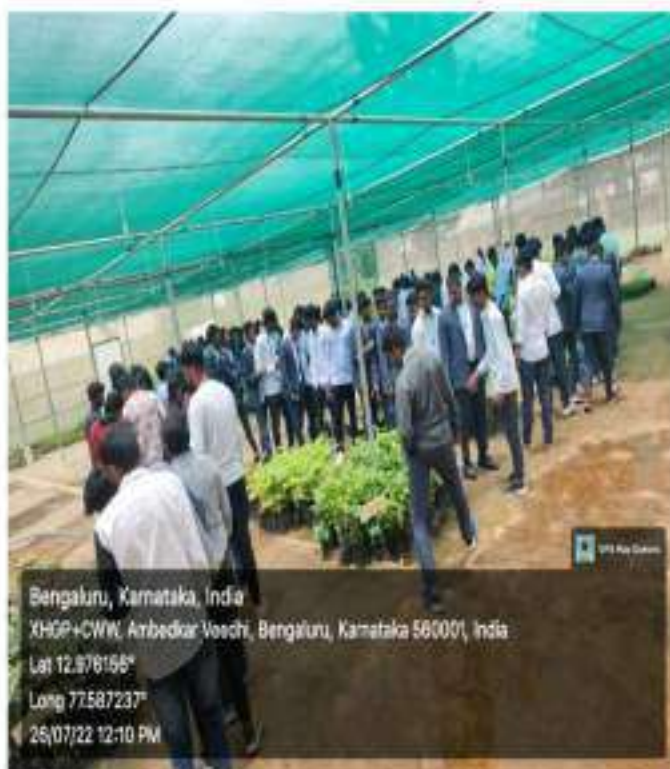

Introduction: The Jawaharlal Nehru Center for Advanced Scientific Research [JNCASR] is a multidisciplinary research institute located at Jakkur, Bangalore, India. It was established by the Department of Science and Technology of the Govt. of India. In 2019, JNCASR was ranked 7th among the world's top ten research institutes published by Nature Journal.

The founder of JNCASR is Professor C.N.R. Rao, who holds BHARAT RATNA and Honorary president of JNCASR. It was established in 1989. Their mandate is to pursue and promote world class research and training at the frontiers of science and engineering covering broad areas ranging from materials to genetics. It provides a vibrant academic ambience holding more than 500 researchers. Researchers at the centre are divided into seven units: Chemistry, Physics of materials, Engineering Mechanics, Evolutionary and organism biology, Molecular biology and genetics, New chemistry, Theoretical sciences, Educational technology and Geo-dynamics. There are two off-campus unit: Chemical biology and condensed matter theory. JNCASR has a faculty to student ratio of about 1:4 and state of the art experiment, computational and infrastructural facilities. It offers Ph.D programmes, as well as an integrated Ph.D [Post-Bachelor's Degree] programme in Materials science. Apart from training it's own students through a wide spectrum of courses, the center's Summer Research Fellowship Programme hosts some of the brightest undergraduates in the country. The Educational Technology unit procedure teaching aids and educational materials.

Experience: The industrial visit to JNCASR was organized on 16-12-2022 by the management of Soundarya Institute of Management and Science. This visit was very informative. From a research point of view students gained perspective about the various domains and the latest innovations and its applications in the field of science. Students had a wide exposure to several instrumentation principles and technologies involved in analysis of samples. The basic principles and mechanisms of instrumentation were explained very well by the professors of JNCASR.

Title: Revolutionizing Retail: Image Recognition in Deep Learning for Product Recognition
